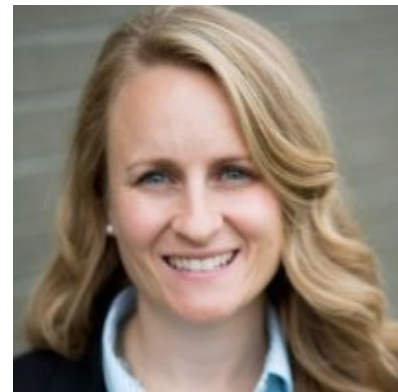

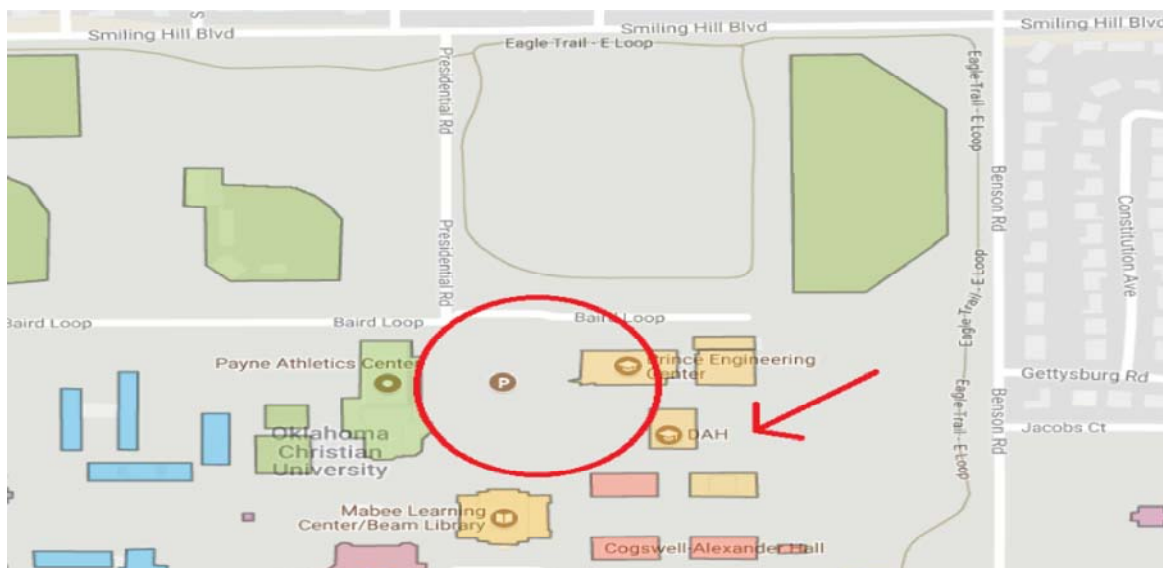

## **eCYBERMISSION - STEM Competition Virtual Judges NEEDED**

eCYBERMISSION is an online STEM competition through National Science Teachers Association. We are in need of virtual judges for this competition cycle and seeking STEM professionals. The deadline to register is February 28th. It will take less than 5 minutes to register.

STEM Professionals Needed as Virtual Volunteers! eCYBERMISSION, a web-based Science, Technology, Engineering and Math competition for 6th-9th grade students is still in need of volunteers as virtual judges for this competition cycle. Registration deadline is drawing near. Please consider sharing with your network and members.

STEM Competition Virtual Judges- Volunteers will spend time (self-paced) from March 14-30, 2018 to review, score, and provide comments on team submissions. We ask volunteers to score 10-15 submissions, which on average, takes 30 minutes per submission. eCYBERMISSION provides a clear judging rubric for all submissions as well as support from the eCYBERMISSION Volunteer Team.
